*I've enclosed a picture report from my  
visit to South Dakota in September.*

I wrapped up the Month of September with a trip to South Dakota. I have preached a fall revival for Missionary Duane Earwood for the past three years. This was the second year under the Gospel Tent. I took two young men with me – Seth Skinner and Zack Norton. It was a good trip. We had the opportunity to help put the floor joist in the new building for Calvary Baptist Church in Chamberlain, SD. The meeting was well attended but not as good as last year. We had a few visitors come in and I'm grateful for the opportunity to present them with the Gospel. After the meeting I took Seth and Zack to visit Mt. Rushmore and The Crazyhorse Memorial in the Black Hills. I don't think they were impressed based on the 'few' pictures they took of the memorials – however, I think they were much impressed with Elk, Bison and Mountain Goats at Bear Country USA. We visited a young couple that I married last December – Nathan and Stefanie Johnson. Bro. Nate is stationed there in the Air Force as a MP Dog Handler. The Johnson's were kind enough to allow us to stay in their home, which was on the Elgin Air Force base. It was impressive to watch the B1 Bombers doing 'touch and go' training – we parked at the end of the run way and watched the 'big bird' come right over our head. Nate and Stefanie are expecting their first child in May 2009. Of late, Nate has hurt his back and his knee and having a lot of trouble with them – please remember this young preacher and his wife in your prayers.

Returning from South Dakota, I had a hodge-podge of short meetings. I preached a youth rally in Gainesville, GA at Canaan Baptist Church which was a great success. I also preached two nights at the Hollingsworth Campmeeting in Cornelia, GA. They borrowed the PTM Gospel Tent and this was the first time that I was able to see the tent erected (the tent was used twice in October). I was home for my home church's annual youth rally. We had about 185 on Friday night and 125 on Saturday. Praise the Lord for 5 Saved during the Rally. We always end the youth rally weekend with a big push on our buses – we had a record 112 on the buses and 14 saved that day!!! **TO GOD BE THE GLORY!!** I preached a three night meeting at Emmanuel Baptist Church in Gaylesville, AL where the highlight was a re-preaching of a message I developed when I pastored entitled "Why I don't celebrate Halloween". The meeting was well attended. I am presently closing out a meeting at Miracle Baptist Church in Falling Water, TN. I am grateful for the opportunity to preach Sunday services at Utopia Baptist and White Oak Springs Baptist. I also preached the 'new building addition' dedication at Heaven's View Baptist Church.

I will be preaching at the Temple Baptist Church in Gainesville Oct 26-30; the Calvary Baptist Church in Culpeper, VA Nov 3-5; Shady Grove Baptist in Sevierville, TN Nov 17-23AM. I leave for PANAMA, SD Nov 29<sup>th</sup> for a 13 day mission trip visiting Bro. Franklin Booth and others. Then I will close the year's meetings at Calvary Baptist Church in Riceville, TN Dec 15-19. I had a cancelation mid November that I was not able to book, so Melissa and I are borrowing a friend's cabin for a 'get away week' before the baby arrives – I am looking forward to the days off.
