Dear Friends & Supporters:

With Thanksgiving right around the corner, I want to share an 'outline' thought with you. Our text would come from a wonderful Psalm – number 116. Our focus would be on verse 12 where the Psalmist ask "*What shall I render unto the Lord for all his benefits toward me?*" What a searching question – what could we give back – render to the LORD for all that HE has done for us? In the verses that follow, the Psalmist actually answers his own question – notice:

Vs 12 **ENJOY SALVATION'S BENEFITS** – *“take the cup of salvation”* The LORD wants us to take advantage of everything that is given to us as Born Again Believers.

Vs 12 **ERNEST SUPPLICATION** – *“call upon the name of the LORD”* Surely the LORD wants to hear from us – He wants us to communicate with Him through prayer.

Vs 13 **EXPRESS SINCERITY through FAITHFULNESS** – *“I will pay my vows”* God expects His children to walk in Faithfulness.

Vs 13 **EXPLAIN my STORY** – *“in the presence of all his people”* We must be willing to share the testimony of God's goodness and salvation in our own lives.

Vs 16 **EMBRACE SERVANTHOOD** - *“truly I am thy servant”* How it must delight the heart of God for His children to serve willingly and lovingly.

Vs 17 **EAGER SALUTATIONS OF PRAISE** - *“I will offer to thee the sacrifice of Thanksgiving”* Enough said!

Vs 19 **ENTER THE SANCTUARY** – *“In the courts of the LORD's house”* What greater way could we express our gratitude than to be faithful in HIS house.

That's just a skeleton of an outline – but I hope that it will be a blessing, encouragement and challenge to each of us during these days of Thanksgiving ... God help us to GIVE SOMETHING BACK – to Render something to the LORD for his MANY, MANY Blessings upon each of us.

May God Bless each of you abundantly at this special season of Thanksgiving. Our hearts are grateful to God that he has placed you in our life to be such a blessing to us! Thank you so much for all that you do for this ministry.
