Dear Friends and Supporters:

While I generally try to use the communication we send with receipts to notify and inform our supporters of 'ministry wide' activities and functions, I will deviate from that this month to give you a personal update.

We have certainly seen the faithfulness of God and the genuine love and generosity of the children of God this month as several churches and individuals have sent special MEDICAL GIFTS to assist Melissa and I in these days. I am very grateful to Pastor Mark Stroud and the other pastors that took it upon themselves to send letters out on our behalf about our specific situation and to those of you that have responded so kindly.

As most of you are aware, I became very ill in early July with pneumonia that turned quite nasty creating a pocket of bacteria laden fluid around my right lung. The fluid congealed (they say like jello) and I was moved to Piedmont hospital in Atlanta for surgery to remove the pocket. All in all, I was in the hospital 12 days including the surgery. I obviously was much improved when I came home – but the overall sickness had extended well over a month. I had to cancel most of July and all of August meetings. I am trying to slowly recuperate at home now --- it's has been a real challenge getting my strength and stamina back. I experienced what was termed a 'cardiac event' while in the hospital and so now I have to see a cardiologist – I have no idea what to expect there – my appointment is August 25th – **I would ask that you make this a special matter of prayer.**

Again, Melissa and I are so very grateful for our faithful monthly supporters that continue to stand with us in these days – I promise by God's Grace to be back on the road serving HIM as quickly as I can!! We also appreciate the special financial help that has been coming in to offset loss of revival and meeting love offerings and to assist with the extra expenses of the illness. Many have ask about the outstanding medical expense – right now, we are still watching insurance settle claims and we really don't know what the outstanding balance will be. I hope to start working back into the pulpit in September, but of course that's dependant upon my improvement and the cardiologist visit – again, please pray – we will keep you posted.
